

# KISO 512 Butyl – PP-coated butyl

## Window mounting tape

We have designed a special window sealing tape for use when mounting windows in walls, which makes the sealing extra tight around the window. It is developed so that there are two adhesive surfaces opposite of each other.

First the tape is mounted on the frame by pressing on the aluminium foil. Underneath the part, consisting of butyl on the picture above, a strip of nonwoven paper is applied to prevent the tape to stick to the frame. Then, this part of the tape can be pushed against the wall from the inside, creating a completely sealed joint between the window and the wall, after the window is mounted.

Gently put the frame in the wall, and fix it.

Use a spackle or another tool to press the sealing tape against the wall from the inside. After this the joint backing and the sealant is applied.
